

National Black Graduate Student Association William Lawson, Jr. Memorial Scholarship Form

There will be only three \$500 scholarships awarded. The winners will be announced at the NBGSA Closing Banquet. The check for the \$500 will be sent to the winners after fall enrollment is confirmed with winner's University Registrar. A letter verifying enrollment, including class schedule must be sent to the Vice President for Administrative Affairs before the check is awarded.

It normally takes 2-4 weeks to process a check request. Please keep this in mind when submitting your verification information.

Requirements

To apply you must,

1. be a member of the NBGSA;
2. be entering or pursuing a Masters, Doctoral or Professional degree in the fall;
3. give NBGSA permission to use photos of you taken at the conference, on website, in publication, etc.;
4. be a U.S. citizen;
5. have a 3.00 GPA or higher;
6. be able to attend the national conference; and
7. submit ONE complete packet which should include: application, 3 recommendation letters, Official transcript(s), and a page essay on this year's national theme:
Brilliance in Black.

Application packet can be emailed or mailed.

If emailing packet, the following documents must be included in a single email: application and essay. Recommendation letters must be submitted by professor using their school email address. (Any other address will not be accepted)

If using U.S. postal mail, submit the following documents must be included: application, recommendation letters, and essay.

Official transcripts **must** be mailed.
